If you've already taken a painting class, bring what materials you have.

Everyone should bring the following:

- 1 Pad of Canvas Sheets 9x12 (Fredrix or Canson)
- Flat brush ½" or ¾" wide
- Small round brush
- Small painting knife that's flexible
- Pad of palette paper
- Roll of painter's tape

Acrylic painters should bring:

Large water container

Roll of paper towels

Disposable plastic containers
