Two 30" x 36," and a pack of six 11" x 14" canvases Keep in mind, you may need more canvases depending on how you work.

Acrylic Paint- I highly recommend using: Golden acrylic paints (high flow, fluids or heavy body or a combination). This brand has a high pigment load, and a diverse array of colors to choose from; they also have iridescent and interference colors, which can really enhance a piece. Colors are your choice. You may also use other brands, like Amsterdam, Holbein, Winsor & Newton, Grumbacher, and many more (this is not an extensive list, just suggestions)

Paint brushes- I recommend a variety: angular, round tip, flat, mop and filbert

High gloss and matte varnish

Palette knives

Sticks for dripping paint (popsicle, actual sticks, paint stirrers, etc.)

**Sponges** 

Plastic cup or container for water

Gloves

Palmolive soap

Paper towels or cloth for wiping and cleaning brushes & materials

Any items that can create texture
