Two 30 " $\times 36$," and a pack of six 11 " $\times 14$ " canvases
Keep in mind, you may need more canvases depending on how you work.
Acrylic Paint- I highly recommend using: Golden acrylic paints (high flow, fluids or heavy body or a combination). This brand has a high pigment load, and a diverse array of colors to choose from; they also have iridescent and interference colors, which can really enhance a piece. Colors are your choice. You may also use other brands, like Amsterdam, Holbein, Winsor \& Newton, Grumbacher, and many more (this is not an extensive list, just suggestions)

Paint brushes- I recommend a variety: angular, round tip, flat, mop and filbert
High gloss and matte varnish
Palette knives
Sticks for dripping paint (popsicle, actual sticks, paint stirrers, etc.)
Sponges
Plastic cup or container for water
Gloves
Palmolive soap
Paper towels or cloth for wiping and cleaning brushes \& materials
Any items that can create texture
