## Int-Adv Acrylic Ink Painting

One $20 " \times 20$ " canvas, as well as a pack of $8 " \times 10$ " or 11 " $\times 14$ " canvases Pack of 8 "x 10 " or 11 " x 14 " canvases

Brushes: an angled paint brush, filbert, and a fine tip paint brush
Ink roller
High gloss varnish
Painter's tape
91\% rubbing alcohol
Toothpicks
Painter's palette
Small plastic containers (for mixing and keeping paints)
Small plastic pipettes
Latex gloves (if you don't want ink on your hands)
Hair dryer and/or a heat gun

## Extension cord

For acrylic inks, I recommend: Daler \& Rowney inks. For colors: at least 5-6 different colors of your choice (you may want to purchase more after the first class).
Plastic cup or container for water
Palmolive soap
Paper towels or cloth for wiping and cleaning brushes \& materials
