\$50 supply fee due at first class for specialty materials

For the first class, bring four canvases and other requested supplies listed below.

Wooden, or cotton canvasses—purchase at least 12 canvases—I recommend 9" x 12" or 11" x 14"

Please keep in mind, you may need more canvases depending how you work. Wooden canvases are more expensive, but they are also sturdier than cotton canvases, and they do not sag like a cotton canvas can.

Hair dryer

Extension cord

Mask

Paper towels

Painter's tape

Acrylic paints- You will use a lot of white, which I recommend purchasing Artist's Loft brand in the large one-quart container, which is inexpensive. Also purchase black paint, and other colors are your choice. I would choose a variety. The brand of paint does impact the piece, so I recommend using: Golden (high flow, fluids or heavy body), Master's Touch, Amsterdam, Deco Art Americana Décor Metallics, and many more (this is not an extensive list, just suggestions).
