Cotton or wooden canvasses-purchase at least one bulk pack-16" x $20^{\prime \prime}, 20^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ " or 18" x 24 "
Please keep in mind, you may need more canvases depending on how you work and that cotton canvases can sag. I recommend purchasing wooden canvases online at Michaels or Amazon.

## Painter's tape

Acrylic paints- You will use a lot of white, which I recommend purchasing Artist's Loft brand in the large one-quart container, which is inexpensive. Also purchase black paint, and other colors are your choice. I would choose a variety. The brand of paint does impact the piece, so I recommend using: Golden (high flow, fluids or heavy body), Master's Touch, Amsterdam, Deco Art Americana Décor Metallics, and many more (this is not an extensive list, just suggestions).
