Ultramarine Blue

Cobalt Violet

Magenta

Alizarin crimson

Burnt sienna

Cadmium orange

Titanium white

Flake white

Cadmium yellow pale

Raw sienna

Viridian

Painting surface

Lead white ACM panel - no bigger than 11x14

Centurion deluxe professional oil primed linen panels - no bigger than 11x14 (www.amazon.com/Centurion-Deluxe-Primed-Linen-Panel)

Brushes

Rosemary "set" 20 Beginner (these are great for painting flowers)

Red dot one stroke size 3/8

Badger fan series 37 size medium

Large Background brush 1-1/2"

One or 2 bristle brushes (Robert Simmons or Raphael Paris classic) filbert 4 or 6 or both (www.amazon.com)

<u>Medium</u>

Turpenoid odorless solvents (to clean brushes) Stand oil (mix 50% stand oil with 50% turpenoid in glass bottle before class
