Paris oil-primed linen 9x12 not bigger than 11x14

(Paris Oil Primed Ultimate Stretched Linen Canvas Jerry's Artarama)

OR

Lead white ACM panel size 9x12 (off natural pigments)

Rare and Hard to Find Art Supplies | Artist Supplies | Natural Pigments | Rublev Colours Artist Supplies | Pigments, Oil Paint, Watercolors, Cold Wax

OR

Centurion deluxe professional oil primed linen panels

(3 pack off Amazon prime 9x12 or 11x14)

### <u>Medium</u>

Artist painting medium by Windsor & Newton- this is a premixed stand oil/solvent or you may make your own mixture of stand oil/mineral spirits. Approx 40% oil / 60% solvent Wooden palette (not white)

Roll of paper towels

Palette knife

Odorless mineral spirits terpenoid

Baby wipes to clean your brushes so you don't ruin them

Bar of soap

Gloves for washing brushes
