







Paint Naples & the Basics of Color

BRUSHES: Natural Bristle: Brights #2, 4, 8 & 10

Synthetic White Fiber: Brights #1, 2, 4, 8, & 10. Rounds #1

PAINTS: I recommend Grumbacker paints (good quality & reasonably priced)

Required Colors: (Artist (Not Student) Grade 12 Colors (37 ml. tubes)

- 1 Cool Yellow (Cadmium Yellow Pale or Lemon Yellow or Zink Yellow)
- 1 Warm Yellow (Cadmium Yellow MEDIUM)
- 1 Cadmium Orange
- 1 Warm Red (Cadmium Red LIGHT)
- 1 Cool Red (Thalo Rose) (Alizarin Crimson is NOT a substitute, ROSE substitutes only)
- 1 Dioxazine Purple
- 1 Cool Blue (Ultramarine Blue)
- 1 Warm Blue (Thalo or Turquoise)
- 1 Thalo Green or 1 Permanent Green Light
- 1 Permalba White (150 ml. tube)

Optional "Earth" or "Grayed" colors:

- 1 Naples Yellow
- 1 Yellow Ochre
- 1 Raw Umber
- 1 Ivory Black

CANVAS: Stretched or On Board

To begin any of the following sizes: (8 x 10), (9 x 12), (11 x 14), (12 x 16)

Your kit should include:

- 1 Palette Knife or Painting Knife (Recommended: Jerry's Catalogue: (#15) #56201)
- 1 Air tight Brush Washer- metal cup within a cup is the best (see Jerry's Catalogue)
- 1 Odorless Turpenoid 16oz
- 1 Linseed Oil (for Medium: 3/4 turpenoid 1/4 linseed oil)
- 1 Disposable Paper Paeltte Pad (12" x 16")
- 1 Small Sketchpad, HB pencils, Eraser
- 1 Roll of Paper Towels (or old towel)
- 1 Pliars
- 1 Scissors

Masking or Painter tape

*Available locally at Family Hobby on 10th St. N. or online at Jerry's (800-827-8478)

REQUIRED: Purchase of the studio work book "PAINT NAPLES: AND THE BASICS OF COLOR" available from the instructor at the first class. (\$35.00. cash or check only)

IMPORTANT: Before & in preparation for the first class, review the class supply list & purchase at a minimum, a warm & cool version of each of the 3 primaries listed, as well as white. For brushes, bring a large and small bristle & fiber bright brushes.
