Each year the Naples Art Association has opportunities for artists to demonstrate or sample their work in front of an audience through a variety of events, including Dinner with Artists.

- Artists must be able to demonstrate and/or sample their work within a 45-minute time frame
- Artists may demonstrate in any medium
- Artists must be outgoing and openly demonstrate their skills and discuss their techniques.
- Demonstrations should leave the guest with inspiration and a deeper appreciation of the creative process for each medium
- Demonstrators must present high standards of artistic skill and creative design
