



Welcome!

We are excited to offer your student the opportunity to advance their artistic skills. Additionally, creative expression is part of self-discovery and a healthy lifestyle. We have been working hard to prepare a Health and Safety plan for our summer ARTScool participants. The campus facility has been thoroughly disinfected both inside and out. Naples Art is committed to complying with local and national safety recommendations as well as instituting measures unique to our campus. For Summer ARTScool 2020 the following new safety features and health practices have been put into place:

ARTScool Covid-19 Safety Measures

1. Adjustments are being made to the morning drop off procedures to relieve the crowding in the lobby area. As summer nears, these changes will be communicated via email.
2. To permit social distancing, we are reducing the maximum number of students per group to 9 or fewer with one instructor per class. Adult monitors will be present to assist the instructor with studio procedures, bathroom and rest breaks.
3. Lunch will be held in the Watson Gallery and there will be limited outside play time utilizing both front and back decks. To promote distancing, students will be offered individual games or activities to play with outside, are encouraged to bring a beach towel to sit on (please mark with their name), plus there will also be a movie playing in the Watson as an alternative option.
4. Studio spaces have been reconfigured to allow for 6 feet social distance seating and traffic patterns have been created by placing tape on the floors to clearly mark pathways.
5. Naples Art staff is cleaning bathrooms and disinfecting doors, handles and classroom surfaces throughout the day. Students will be encouraged to take a disinfectant wipe to handle all knobs, handles and levers in the bathrooms.
6. Students will wash hands upon entering the classroom, after each activity and when exiting the classroom.

7. Tools and/or materials/supplies will be pre-packed for each student to use during class with NO sharing throughout the week. All tools will get a disinfectant bath and tables, chairs and equipment will be wiped down between classes.
8. Frequent and thorough hand washing by faculty, staff, students, and visitors will be encouraged. To facilitate hand washing at breaks and lunch there will be an additional outdoor sink installed for the summer.
9. If any staff, faculty, or students are coughing, sneezing or in general not feeling well, please stay at home, and follow the advice of a health professional. Any student or faculty *demonstrating* health issues will be asked to leave. We are currently researching the purchase of a contactless thermometer that may be used on a daily basis.
10. Masks will be worn by all staff and instructors. Mask wearing is not mandatory for students at this time, but is strongly encouraged. This policy could change.

Naples Art will strictly adhere to these measures to ensure everyone's safety. Failure to adhere to these measures will result in the dismissal of your child with no refund option.
