



## Present Work for Jury Review

Thank you for your interest in participating in Art in the Park.

The jury process will begin virtually on the following dates:

October 15, 2020  
December 3, 2020

You must register for the jury process by 5:00 pm 1 day before the jurying date you wish to participate in. You can register online at <https://naplesart.org/outdoor-shows/online-registration/>. The registration fee to jury-in for all Art in the Park events, **except January, 2021**, is \$20 per entry, which is non-refundable. If you want to jury in for multiple mediums, you must pay to jury for each medium (Select **Other** on the on-line form and write in **Jury**).

Artists who are interested in submitting work to the jury process must:

1. Have registered on-line and paid their jury fee in advance.
2. Send (email) 4 images of finished work to [Maureen.roberts@naplesart.org](mailto:Maureen.roberts@naplesart.org) by 5:00 PM the day of the jury process (either October 15, 2020 or December 3, 2020), along with a scanned copy of the jury application (application attached below). Please use Subject: ART IN THE PARK JURY
3. Include an image of your booth set up if you have one – optional
4. If you are an artist with multiple mediums, you must be juried in for each medium.

The jury process will commence October 16<sup>th</sup> or December 4<sup>th</sup> and is scheduled to be completed in about 5 days. The review process may take longer depending on how many applicants there are. The jurors base their scores on the Art in the Park Criteria and all decisions are final. Upon acceptance, the work displayed in your booth must be reflective of that submitted for jury. Naples Art has the right to ask the artist to remove any work that is not in compliance with the rules or does not reflect what was submitted for jury. Artists are notified of their status by email within one – two weeks.

Key points of information:

- Please fill out the Jury Application form at the bottom of this note and email it with your artwork images.
- If you are an artist with multiple mediums, you must be juried in for each medium.

- Once you are juried in, you do not need to jury in annually. If you take more than a two-year break, that didn't involve participating in Naples Art shows, you must re-jury for Art in the Park.
- This is a blind jury so your name should not be visible on any of your images or on your booth photo. Please read the criteria so you understand what the jurors are looking for.
- By participating in the jury process you are attesting to the fact that you are the artist, designer and manufacturer of your artwork. We are looking for hand-made items nothing that is manufactured by someone else and no buy/sell items are allowed.
- If you don't have a booth image, you may be conditionally accepted upon your booth presentation at your first Art in the Park show.
- Artists are notified of the results by email within a week or two.

Art in the Park is juried based on the following criteria and guidelines:

**CONCEPT:**

Artwork must be original in design and executed by the exhibiting artist.

**DESIGN:**

Work to be executed using composition, balance, color and texture

**EXECUTION:**

To take the original idea, sketch or plan to completion using the fundamental elements of art

**ORIGINALITY:**

The quality of newness that exists in something not done before or not derived from anything else; a departure from traditional or previous forms; a new idea or approach

To express oneself independently and individually

**PRESENTATION:**

The manner in which work is shown, expressed or laid out for others to view showing a high degree of skill or competence with visual appeal

**COLLABORATION:**

Art teams and/or collaborators that produce a single product may qualify as a single exhibitor. Such a team may not consist of more than two people. If you enter as an artist team or collaboration, it must be clearly noted on the application and in the artist statement. The collaboration must be clearly defined.

## Art in the Park Jury Application

**Application must include** a photo of the booth presentation of the applicant's work. If the applicant does not have a booth image for the jury process, the applicant will receive a conditional acceptance allowing participation in one show where the booth presentation will be evaluated. If presentation is found to be unacceptable, the artists will not be able to participate going forward until satisfactory changes have been made. Please check one of the following:

**Application must include** an artist statement defining materials and processes. (Do not include artist name. This is a blind jury.)

## Art in the Park Jury Application Process for January, 2021

**January, 2021 Art in the Park** will be held on Saturday January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 on Park Street in conjunction with the Naples New Year's Art Show. This is a juried show, with thirteen booths available exclusively to previously juried Art in the Park artists.

Please note that the layout of 13 booths is subject to city/county regulations and may change.

**Juried Art in the Park** artists interested in applying for January, 2021 Art in the Park show require the submission of 4 images of the artist's work and 1 image of booth presentation. When applying in two mediums, work in each must be substantially different and the required images must be submitted for each medium. A separate application fee is required for each application. If an artist is not accepted in a certain medium, they may not display that medium in their booth.

The 4 images of the artist's work and 1 booth image must be submitted to the Events Manager, Maureen Roberts, via email at [maureen.roberts@naplesart.org](mailto:maureen.roberts@naplesart.org). Each entry requires a \$10 application fee which is non-refundable. If you want to jury in for multiple mediums, you must pay an additional \$10 application fee to jury for each medium.

The deadline for submissions is October 30, 2020.

Status Notification will be November 12, 2020.

### **Jury and Exhibit Space Fees**

\$10 Application Fee (non-refundable)

\$175 Exhibit Space Fee (Payable upon acceptance)

Accepted artists will be required to submit their **booth fee payment** by the **deadline date of November 27, 2020** for participation. If the booth fee is not received by the deadline date, the artist is essentially forfeiting his/her participation in the festival. Once the booth payment deadline has passed, we start calling people off the wait list to fill the booths.

**Artist Cancellation: No refund after December 11, 2020. Cancellation/Refund Exception: Death in the family. Immediate family includes the following:** Someone's spouse, parents and grandparents, children and grandchildren, brothers and sisters, mother in law and father in law, brothers in law and sisters in law, daughters in law and sons in law. **In cases of death: Refunds require a copy of the obituary.**

**CANCELLATION:** In the event that the "Show" is interrupted or prevented without contributory fault or negligence of either party because of war, act of God, fire, national or local calamity, national or local pandemic other than COVID-19, riot or civil disorder, any act or regulation of public authorities, or any unforeseen occurrence or labor dispute, including strike or lockout of employees, then obligations of the parties shall be suspended to the extent made necessary, and booth fees less operating expenses shall be refunded. Neither the Artist nor the "Show" shall be liable to the other for any damages caused thereby.

**COVID-19 CANCELLATION:** In the event that the "Show" is **prevented** without contributory fault or negligence of either party because of **COVID-19**, then obligations of the parties shall be suspended to the extent made necessary, and booth fees shall be refunded. Neither the Artist nor the "Show" shall be liable to the other for any damages caused thereby.

In the event that the "Show" is **interrupted** without contributory fault or negligence of either party because of **COVID-19**, then obligations of the parties shall be suspended to the extent made necessary, and booth fees less operating expenses shall be refunded. Neither the Artist nor the "Show" shall be liable to the other for any damages caused thereby.

**All refunds are subject to a \$25.00 processing fee.**
