We have been working hard to prepare a Health and Safety plan for our summer ARTScool participants. The campus facility has been thoroughly disinfected both inside and out. Naples Art is committed to complying with local and national safety recommendations as well as instituting measures unique to our campus. For Summer ARTScool 2021 the following new safety features and health practices have been put into place:

## **ARTScool Covid-19 Safety Measures**

1. Adjustments are being made to the morning drop off procedures to relieve the crowding in the lobby area.
2. To permit social distancing, we are reducing the maximum number of students per class.
3. Lunch will be held on the back deck. Masks will not be required during outdoor breaks and lunch.
4. Studio spaces have been reconfigured to allow for social distance seating.
5. Naples Art staff is cleaning bathrooms and disinfecting doors, handles and classroom surfaces throughout the day. Students will be encouraged to take a disinfectant wipe to handle all knobs, handles and levers in the bathrooms.
6. Students will wash hands upon entering the classroom, after each activity and when exiting the classroom.
7. Frequent and thorough hand washing by faculty, staff, students, and visitors will be encouraged.
8. If any staff, faculty, or students are coughing, sneezing or in general not feeling well, please stay at home, and follow the advice of a health professional. Any student or faculty demonstrating health issues will be asked to leave.
9. Masks will be worn by all staff, student and instructors.

Naples Art will strictly adhere to these measures to ensure everyone's safety. Failure to adhere to these measures will result in the dismissal of your child with no refund option.
