



Alcohol and Acrylic Ink Painting

Christine Otis

One bottle of 91% or higher of isopropyl alcohol

Alcohol inks (color choice and brand are up to you—I would choose at least 6 different colors)

Glycerin

Stylus

Hair dryer or heat gun

Pipettes

Blower for inks

At least 9 needle tip bottles

Palette that can hold inks

Mask

Gloves

Scotch tape

For acrylic inks, I recommend: Daler & Rowney inks

For colors: at least 5-6 different colors of your choice

Brushes: an angled paint brush and a round tipped brush

Ink roller

High gloss varnish

Painter's tape

At least one pack of 11" x 14" cotton canvas

Plastic cup or container for water

Palmolive soap

Paper towels or cloth for wiping and cleaning brushes & materials

Q-tips

Flat box to bring home artwork
