Berries – Blue, black and raspberries and leaves\*  
Ferns\*  
Red hibiscus blossoms  
Sumac leaves and berries\*  
Eucalyptus\*  
Rose bush/stem leaves\*  
Purple basil  
Black Berries and Leaves\*  
Black Eyed Susan  
Sunflower petals  
Daffodils petals  
Lisianthus flowers and leaves (Stock flowers)  
Elder berries
