



Advanced Pour Painting

Canvas: six wooden 6" x 6"; six wooden 4" x 4"; three cotton canvases 12" x 12"; two cotton canvases 18" x 24"; one 20" x 20"

*Please keep in mind, you may need more canvases depending how you work—the size is your choice, but do not exceed 18" x 24"

Hair dryer

Extension cord

Crème brûlée torch (be sure it's filled with butane)

Mask

Palette knife

Paper towels

Painter's tape

Acrylic paints

*You will use a lot of white and black, which I recommend purchasing Artist's Loft brand in the large one-quart container, which is inexpensive.

For other acrylic paint colors, which does impact the piece, I recommend using: Golden (high flow, fluids or heavy body), Daler & Rowney, Liquitex, Holbein, Winsor & Newton, Utrecht, Grumbacher, Art Deco, and many more (this is not an extensive list, just suggestions).
