Supply fee of \$40 due to the instructor at the first class for specialty supplies.

Wooden or cotton 11" x 14" canvasses—purchase a pack of at least six canvases

Keep in mind, you may need more canvases depending how you work. The emphasis for this class is taking your time to create your design by using colors and the techniques involved.

Hair dryer

Extension cord

Crème brûlée torch (be sure it's filled with butane)

Mask

Paper towels

Painter's tape

Acrylic paints. You may use a lot of white and black, which I recommend purchasing Artist's Loft brand in the large one-quart container, which is inexpensive. For other acrylic paint colors, which does impact the piece, I recommend using: Golden (high flow, fluids or heavy body), Daler & Rowney, Liquitex, Holbein, Winsor & Newton, Utrecht, Grumbacher, Art Deco, and many more (this is not an extensive list, just suggestions).

Paint brushes: I recommend a variety: angular, round tip, flat, mop and filbert

Palette knives

Plastic cup or container for water

Palmolive soap

Paper towels or cloth for wiping and cleaning brushes & materials
